1. Database of on-going, multi-national stroke research

The report from the workshop “Methods to improve recruitment and retention in stroke trials” was published in *International Journal of Stroke* in April 2016.


4. Publication of report from the ESO/The Lancet Neurology symposium at the 2nd ESO Conference in Barcelona in 2016
