

ESO committe Paediatric Stroke

The ESO committee Paediatric stroke has been founded in 2017

We had a first meeting during the European Paediatric Neurology conference in June 2017

We have built up a European Paediatric stroke Network and have now met the base line for international studies within Europe. We had a first project, which was submitted for financial support, but unfortunately was not funded and we are working further on it.

We will have the 2nd Paediatric Stroke meeting in June 2018 in Bern Switzerland and hope to stimulate even further the membership in ESO of Neuropaediatrician interested in stroke. In addition, we will discuss different stroke research topics during this meeting.

We will have a Research meeting (under the hospice form the EPNS) in September 2018 were the Paediatric stroke group will meet again to further discuss European approaches to research in Paediatric stroke

The goal of our committee is to involve more neuropaediatrician into ESO to have beside EPNS a platform dedicated to Paediatric stroke. The difficulties for the Paediatric stroke group at the time being is, that the two official societies supporting us – the ESO and the EPNS both have their main interests more in non Paediatric or non-stroke topics respectively. We are working on getting more sessions with topics, which are important for Paediatric strokologists- in ESO that would attract more Paediatric neurologist working in the field of stroke. We are also aware, that having only a few paediatric neuropaediatrician attending the meeting, that goal cannot be reached in the near future.
