## Report of the ESO Education Committee



- Marios Psychogios, Mirjam Heldner and Derya Uluduz joined the committee
- Coronavirus has significantly impacted on the planned activities for the year
- A call for ESO-funded, focussed workshops resulted in approval of an excellent proposal for a 2 day workshop in Bergen on Stroke in the Young. However, this course has been postponed due to the coronavirus pandemic until 2021. Calls for further workshops are similarly on hold
- The Summer School planned for 2020 in Caen, France has similarly been postponed, aiming to happen in August / September 2021.
- As such, subsequent courses will now be held in Birmingham in 2022 and L'Aquila in 2023.
- We continue to support the ESO winter schools in Bern and Edinburgh as remote courses
- We supported the very successful ESO GAINS WSO early career workshop, also remote
- The department-to-department visiting program also continued, albeit in a more limited form this year
- We are developing an online ESO Stroke Education platform 'eSTEP' and have appointed an Editorial board, chaired by Branko Malojcic. A provider has been selected, and content identified. The platform is currently under construction.
