

2019 Report of the ESO Guideline Board

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2019

- The following ESO Guidelines have been completed in 2019 and have been published in the ESJ:
 - ✓ Antithrombotic treatment for secondary prevention of stroke and other thromboembolic events in patients with stroke or TIA and non-valvular atrial fibrillation. A European Stroke Organisation guideline (ESJ 2019 Vol4(3) 198-223)
 - ✓ European Stroke Organisation (ESO) – European Society for Minimally Invasive Neurological Therapy (ESMINT) guidelines on mechanical thrombectomy in acute ischaemic stroke (ESJ 2019 Mar;4(1):6-12 & J Neurointerv Surg. 2019 Jun;11(6):535-538)
 - ✓ European Stroke Organisation Guideline on Reversal of Oral Anticoagulants in Acute Intracerebral Haemorrhage (ESJ 2019 Vol 4(4) 294-306)
 - ✓ Consensus statements and recommendations from the ESO-Karolinska Stroke Update Conference, Stockholm 11–13 November 2018 (ESJ 2019 Vol4(4) 307-317)

- The following guidelines are expected to be completed in 2020 / 2021:
 - IV thrombolysis
 - TIA Management
 - Management of hypertension in acute ischemic stroke and intracerebral hemorrhage
 - Secondary prevention after stroke in patients without atrial fibrillation
 - Management of unruptured aneurysm
 - Carotid stenosis
 - Brain oedema management in acute stroke
 - Women & Stroke
 - Dysphagia & Stroke (in coop. With ESSD)
 - PFO management in patients with otherwise cryptogenic ischaemic stroke
 - ESO-EAN Guideline on Post-stroke cognitive impairment

- Establishment of an agreement with the ESJ for a new review process starting already at the level of PICO
- The second ESO GL Board SOP (SOP-2) has been prepared
- An instructional manual has been prepared as an accompanying measure in the SAP-E and will be published within this year
- Webinars for the guideline workshop are in preparation
- New APP tool is being investigated and shall be implemented in 2020
