- Membership: From 1st June 2020, I was selected to substitute Prof. Georgios Tsivgoulis that I would like to thank for his admirable leadership during his tenure. The present committee is composed of Robin Lemmens (Belgium), Sami Curtze (Finland), Christos Krogias (Germany), Marta Rubiera (Spain), Ana Aires (Portugal), Ronen Leker (Israel), Aristeidis Katsanos (Greece), Vijay Sharma (Singapore), Nitin Goyal (USA) and myself from Perugia (Italy). The committee convened via web on 16 June 2020 where they expressed their aims to be functioning and able to plan the activity for 2021. Regarding the Committee members, representation includes persons from most European Nations as well as from extra-European countries including Asia and North American.
- Requests for endorsement: 13 requests for endorsements have been received: 10 of these were accepted immediately, 2 were accepted after minor revisions due to the program meeting and its presenters while 1 was rejected. The latter application, 2020 World Critical Care and Anesthesiology Conference, was declined because the program dedicated an insufficient attention to Stroke.
