Report of the ESO Education Committee

- The ESO summer school 2020 (now '21) in Caen happened virtually in October. Despite the move online, this was very successful, with excellent lectures, virtual exposure to the city of Caen and was very well-attended and appreciated
- Planning for ESO 2022 in Birmingham is well-advanced
- The ESO Stroke Education platform (eSTEP) was launched in September, with a rapid expansion of high quality material and increasing users, and now development of dedicated learning modules.
- The online ESO Webinar series was launched, featuring case-based discussion of core and cutting edge topics, with 3/6 webinars released so far. These have again been very successful and very well attended, with a plan to continue.
- The Education committee also provides ESO oversight for the ESO-WSO Gains early career workshop, the Bern Winter School and the department-to-department visiting program.
