## Report of the ESO Education Committee



- The ESO summer school 2022 ran in Birmingham with, our first face-to-face one since COVID, was very successful, well attended, with excellent feedback
- Planning for ESO 2023 in L'Aquila is well underway. The next two summer schools have been selected in Vilnius, Lithuania and Zadar, Croatia.
- The ESO Stroke Education platform (eSTEP) continues to increase its users and educational offerings. The Editorial Board will be expanding by 2 people, and we are keen for ESO committees to support the development of dedicated learning modules.
- The online ESO Webinar series continues, with its second series underway. Attendance is excellent (100-150 people), and the 3rd webinar of the second series is happening in January.
- The Education committee also provides ESO oversight for the Bern Winter School and the department-to-department visiting program.
- The Edinburgh Stroke Research Workshop ran face-to-face in September, was well attended and continues to provide excellent research training.
- Our first 'Focussed Workshop' in Young stroke ran in Norway in April, face to face, with the next two
  course selected, in Utrecht (on subarachnoid haemorrhage) in 2023, followed by Ohrid,
  N.Macedonia on Rare Causes in 2024.
- We are currently establishing a ESO training fellowship, to synthesise our training offerings into a structured programme to promote the development of the next generation.
