



ESOC 2026 Abstract Embargo Policy

Abstract Title Release

- All accepted abstract titles will be published on the website and in the Scientific Programme by mid to late March.

Regular Abstracts

- Information from all regular abstracts must not be released until the beginning of the conference.

Large Clinical Trial Session Abstracts

- Abstracts from the Plenary/Large Clinical Trial sessions, occurring daily from 10:30-12:30 CEST, will be accessible at the conclusion of their respective sessions. Information contained within these abstracts must not be released until each session begins.

Late-Breaking Abstracts

- Information contained in Late-Breaking abstracts must not be released before the start of their respective sessions.

Press and Media Selected Abstracts

- Abstracts selected by ESO for press and media activities (outside of Large Clinical Trial and Late-Breaking abstracts) must not be released before 00:01 CEST on the day they are presented. For further details, please contact: press@eso-stroke.org.

Oral Presentations

- Information from oral presentations and their associated abstracts, excluding Late-Breakers, Large Clinical Trial sessions and press and media selected abstracts, must not be released until the beginning of the conference.

Simultaneous Publications

- Please note that if any simultaneous publication is planned, the embargo policy from the relevant journal must be adhered to.

Violation Consequences

- Violation of the embargo policy may result in the abstract being withdrawn from the conference.
