- **Who Can Apply:** All active ESO members (junior and senior)

- Full CV in English
- Letter of motivation including your expertise, interest, and commitment
- List of publications
- **Workshop Requirement:** Participation in an [ESO Guideline Development Workshop](#) is mandatory *before* starting work on the guideline (not required at time of application).

### **Please Note:**

- **MEMBERS WHO HAVE ALREADY BEEN INVOLVED IN OTHER GUIDELINE PROJECTS SHOULD NOT APPLY**, so that members with limited or no previous involvement are given priority. This applies both to MWG members from a previous open call for applications and to all other MWG members.
- Candidates will be evaluated on: scientific integrity, publication record, clinical expertise, professionalism, self-motivation, availability, and conflict of interest disclosures.
- Final selection will be made by MWG chairs and approved by the ESO Guideline Board, ESO Executive Committee, and the Chair of the DEI Advisory Council, with consideration given to gender and geographical representation.
